Purpose of the processing of personal data in Accounting and tax documents register:

As part of the Controller's activities, personal data is processed during processing of accounting documents and agenda related to its processing.

Scope of data subjects: individuals – sponsors, members of the association

List of personal data: name, surname, title, permanent residence address, temporary residence address, telephone number, email address, date of birth, type and number of identity document, signature, account number of the physical entity

Legal basis of the processing of the personal data: Act No. 431/2002 Coll. on Accounting, as amended, Act No. 222/2004 Coll. on Value Added Tax, as amended, Act No. 40/1964 Coll. Civil Code, as amended, Act No. 152/1994 Coll. on the Social Fund and on amending and supplementing Act No. 286/1992 Coll. on Income Taxes, as amended, Act No. 311/2001 Coll. Labour Code, as amended.

Categories of addressees: social insurance, health insurance companies, tax office and entities entitled by a special regulation the power to decide on the rights and obligations of natural persons (e.g. courts).

The transfer of personal data to third countries is not carried out.

Deadlines for deletion of personal data: 10 years

No automated decision making, including profiling is carried out.

There is no automated decision making, including profiling.

In order to comply with the principle of minimization, all personal data provided by you is within the necessary legal requirement for the purpose of their processing.

The data subjects whose personal data are processed for specified purposes may exercise the following rights:
